Bids will be received until the time and date shown. Due to the complexity of the bid, only names of bidders will be read aloud immediately thereafter at the "Place" indicated above.

Bidder's Conference: Specifications are included herein. There will be no pre-bid conference.

PART A - GENERAL TERMS AND PROVISIONS:

1. Bids: Must be contained in a SEALED envelope addressed to: David Gee, Sheriff, 2008 E 8th Avenue, Tampa, Florida 33605. To prevent inadvertent opening, the bid must be marked as a BID DOCUMENT (including the bid number) on the outside of the envelope.

If our specifications, when included in our Request for Bid, are not returned with your bid, and no specific reference is made to them in your bid, it will be assumed that all specifications will be met. When material, sketches, cuts, descriptive literature, vendor's or manufacturer's specifications which accompany the bid contain information that can be construed or is intended to be a deviation from our specifications, such deviation must be specifically referenced in your bid response.

2. The responsibility for getting the bid to the Sheriff's Office on or before the stated time and date will be solely and strictly the responsibility of the bidder. The Sheriff will in no way be responsible for delays caused by the United States Postal Service or a delay caused by any other occurrence, or any other method of delivery. The bidder shall be responsible for reading very carefully and understanding completely the requirements in the specifications.

Bids will not be accepted after the time specified for receipt. Such bids shall be returned to the vendor unopened with the notation "This Bid Was Received After the Time Designated For the Receipt and Opening of Bids".

3. On-Line Documents: The Hillsborough County Sheriff's Office is publishing documents on its web page www.hcso.tampa.fl.us for the convenience of vendors wanting to do business with the Sheriff and to save tax dollars. This service is public record and the Sheriff is responsible only for documents as published. Any modifications or alterations to the original document language may be cause for rejection of a bid.
4. Time for Consideration: Bidder warrants by virtue of bidding the prices quoted in his bid will be good for an evaluation period of thirty (30) calendar days from the date of bid opening unless otherwise stated. Bidders will not be allowed to withdraw or modify their bids after the opening time and date.
5. Prices: All bids submitted must show the net bid price after any and all discounts allowable have been deducted. **Price(s) bid is/are to be F.O.B. Destination (DELIVERED).** State sales tax and federal excise taxes shall not be included as the Sheriff's Office is tax-exempt. The Sheriff will issue exemption certificates to the successful bidder when requested.

The Bidder's attention is directed to the fact that the tax laws of the State of Florida, including but not limited to Chapter 212, Florida Statutes, apply to this bid matter and that all applicable taxes and fees shall be deemed to have been included in the Bidder's proposal as part of his materials cost, when applicable.

6. Bid Errors: When errors are found in the extension of bid prices, the unit price will govern. Bids having erasures or corrections must be initialed in ink by the bidder.
7. Condition of Materials & Packaging: Unless otherwise indicated, it is understood and agreed that any item offered or shipped on this bid shall be NEW and in FIRST CLASS CONDITION, that all containers shall be new and suitable for storage or shipment and that prices include standard commercial packaging for the items shipped.
8. Claims: The successful bidder will immediately replace missing or damaged items and will be responsible for making any and all claims against carriers.
9. When to Make Delivery: Deliveries resulting from this bid are to be made during the normal working hours of the Sheriff's Office. It is the bidder's responsibility to obtain this information.
10. Manufacturer's Name: Any manufacturers' names, trade names, brand names information and/or catalog numbers used herein are for purpose of description, reference, and establishing general quality levels. Such references are not intended to be restrictive and products of any manufacturer may be offered if they are approved as equals. The determination as to whether any alternate product or service is or is not equal shall be made by the Sheriff's Office and such determination shall be final and binding upon all bidders.
11. Information and Descriptive Literature: Bidder must furnish all information requested in the bid. If specified, each bidder must submit cuts, sketches, descriptive literature and/or complete specifications covering the products offered. Reference to literature submitted with previous bid will not satisfy this provision. Bids which do not comply with these requirements will be subject to rejection.
12. Bid Submittal Costs: Submittal of a bid is solely at the cost of the bidder and the Sheriff's Office in no way is liable or obligates itself for any cost accrued to the bidder in coming up with the Bid Submittal.
13. No Bid: If the receipt of this request for quotation is not acknowledged, Bidder's name may be removed from the bidders' mailing list.

14. Compliance with Occupational Safety and Health Act: Bidder certifies that all material, equipment, etc., contained in his bid meets all OSHA requirements.
15. Public Entity Crimes: Pursuant to Florida Statute 287.132 and 287.133, effective July 1, 1989, the Hillsborough County Sheriff, as a public entity, may not accept any bid or proposal from, award any contract to, or transact any business in excess of the threshold amount provided in Section 287.017, F.S., for Category Two (currently \$25,000) with any person or affiliate on the convicted vendor list for a period of 36 months from the date that person or affiliate was placed on the convicted vendor list unless that person or affiliate has been removed from the list pursuant to Section 287.133 (3)(f), Florida Statute. If you submit a bid or proposal in response to this request, you are certifying that Florida Statute 287.132 and 287.133 does not restrict your submission.
16. Acceptance and Rejection: The Sheriff, Hillsborough County, Florida, reserves the right to reject any or all bids, for cause, to waive irregularities, if any, in any bid, and to accept the bid or bids which in the judgement of the Sheriff is in the best interest of Hillsborough County.
17. It is important that vendor visit sites where services, if applicable, are to be provided to familiarize himself with the scope of the effort required.

1. IN GENERAL

The purpose of these specifications is to describe the annual requirements of the Hillsborough County Sheriff's Office for paint coatings intended for on-site application to interior or exterior surfaces of governmental & institutional buildings and for tools & supplies used in the preparation, application & clean up of paint coatings and personal safety products. The HCSO spends over the \$25,000.00 per year threshold requiring public bid. The exact amount will vary depending on special projects, new construction etc.

2. SCOPE

The Hillsborough County Sheriff's Office (HCSO) is requesting bids for set pricing on the paint & supplies listed in this bid. For items not listed we are asking for a percentage discount off manufacture's list price, or a percentage increase over cost. Invoices must match the contract price. If discount price is extended, the list/cost price must be provided either in a catalog, quote or on the invoice so that the discount can be verified.

MSDS and Technical Data sheets must be provided for each item containing chemicals.

Awardee must have the technology to match existing custom colors at no charge and shall be able to travel to any facility as requested to gather such data. We also request the Awardee maintain a reference file of paint types and colors by facility. A list of facility addresses and contact persons will be provided.

3. DELIVERY

The requirements of this bid include furnishing the commodities as specified herein for all HCSO facility locations countywide. A list of the primary locations, contact persons and phone numbers will be included as an addendum to this document, but deliveries shall not be limited to the listed locations only. Store pick up may also be requested by some facilities. Delivery cost should be included in the proposal price or at no charge. A minimum order for no charge delivery may be considered. Exceptions to any of these requirements, including free delivery locations, may be indicated on the Exceptions page #9.

Awardee will maintain sufficient inventory to deliver material(s) ordered as soon as possible, or within a maximum of seven (7) calendar days After the Receipt of the Order (ARO). Failure to do same shall be considered breach of contract or default and the Hillsborough County Sheriff's Office shall utilize its options as stated herein. Alternate delivery times may be indicated on the Exceptions page, part C1.

Any back-ordered materials shall be made available within fourteen (14) calendar days of the time of back-order (original date of receipt). If the back-order cannot be filled within the time frame of this requirement, then the Hillsborough County Sheriff's Comptroller Manager is to be notified, in writing, thus permitting the Hillsborough County Sheriff's Office to obtain the required materials and/or exercise its options as stated herein.

4. BRAND NAMES

Brand names, when furnished, are for reference purposes and to establish a standard of quality. All paint & paint products must meet the minimum U.S. EPA standards. Bidders must submit brand name and product number for each item quoted as well as other information requested.

For the purpose of establishing an objective comparative base, the Master Painter's Institute (MPI) measurement standards for Volatile Organic Compounds, Gloss Levels, Percent of Volume Solids and Percent of Weight

Solids will be used as comparative informational tools. The evaluation of bids and the determination as to equality of products offered shall be the sole and final responsibility of the Hillsborough County Sheriff's Office.

5. All packaging and shipping shall conform to applicable Federal & State Regulations. Containers shall be clearly labeled as to color & descriptive name (e.g. Latex Interior Wall Paint); Manufacture's batch number and date code; manufacturer's name; instructions for surface preparation, application, thinning and equipment cleanup; various surfaces on which product is recommended for use; cautionary warning label for products containing flammable solvents;

5. ESTIMATED QUANTITIES

Estimated quantities are furnished as a guide for preparing the bid and should not be construed as representing actual quantities to be purchased under this bid.

The Hillsborough County Sheriff's Office reserves the right to add or delete any items from this bid or resulting contract(s) when deemed to be in the best interest of the County.

6. AWARD

Award shall be made to the lowest responsible and responsive bidder meeting specifications, price and other factors considered. The Sheriff's Office reserves the right to award by line item or by overall total, whichever is deemed in the best interest of the Hillsborough County Sheriff.

In the event two (2) or more vendors have submitted the lowest and best bids, preference may be given in the award in the following order. First, to the vendor who has his/her principal place of business in Hillsborough County; second, to the vendor who has a place of business in Hillsborough County; and, third, if the vendors involved in the "tie bid" situation are all located inside/outside Hillsborough County, the toss of a coin will be used to break the tie.

Award notification will be sent to vendors receiving a bid award. Bid results will be available at our web site <http://www.hcso.tampa.fl.us>, on the Purchasing Page. If you do not have internet access, and would like a copy of the bid results, contact the Purchasing Office at (813) 247-8034.

7. EMERGENCY

If and when an emergency requirement should occur, the Sheriff's Office reserves the right to deviate from this contract and procure the item(s) from the most available source.

8. DEFAULT

The contract may be canceled or annulled by the Hillsborough County Sheriff's Office of the Comptroller Manager in whole or in part by written notice of default to the Awardee upon non-performance or violation of contract terms. An award may be made to the next low responsive & responsible bidder, or articles specified may be purchased on the open market similar to those so terminated. Failure of the contractor to deliver materials or services within the time stipulated in these specifications, unless extended in writing by the Office of the Comptroller Manager, shall constitute contract default. Vendors who default on contracts may be removed from the vendor mailing lists for future contracts at the discretion of the Office of the Comptroller Manager

9. CANCELLATION

When deemed to be in the best interest of the Hillsborough County Sheriff's Office, any contract(s) resulting from this specification may be canceled by the following means:

- a. Ten (10) calendar days written notice with cause, or;
- b. Thirty (30) calendar days written notice without cause.

If it becomes necessary to terminate the agreement/contract without cause, all services and/or materials provided through the date of receipt of written notice of cancellation may be invoiced to the Hillsborough County Sheriff's Office and will be considered for payment providing documentation of said expenses are forwarded with the request for payment

10. NEXT LOW BIDDER

In the event of a default by the awarded vendor, the Hillsborough County Sheriff's Office reserves the right to utilize the next low responsive & responsible bidder as the new Awardee. In the event of this occurrence, the next low responsive & responsible bidder shall be required to provide the bid items at the prices as contained on their proposal for this specification for the remainder of the award period.

11. SUBSTITUTION

The Awardee(s) shall not substitute items for like items unless there has occurred some mishap causing a shortage of said items. Such measures may only be enacted after verifying that it will be allowed by the Hillsborough County Sheriff. Any violation of such procedure will be considered cause for cancellation. All substitutes will be annotated as such on the shipping documents.

12. VENDOR QUALIFICATIONS

Vendors may be required to furnish evidence in writing that they maintain permanent places of business and have adequate equipment, finances and personnel to furnish the item or service offered satisfactorily and expeditiously.

The Hillsborough County Sheriff's Office reserves the right to inspect the vendor's place of business and equipment prior to award of any contract, for determining ability to meet terms and conditions as set forth herein.

13. INVOICING AND PAYMENTS

Vendors may invoice the Hillsborough County Sheriff's Office, in duplicate, for material(s) orders as shipped.

The invoice shall show: Purchase Order number, ship to location; item #/description, quantity, unit price (to match contract) & extended price. If a price is discounted from list, the list price must be shown.

Always show purchase order number on invoices.

Payment shall be made in accordance with Section 215.422, F.S., which states the contractor's rights and the Sheriff's Office responsibilities concerning interest penalties and time limits for payment of invoices.

14. WARRANTIES/GUARANTEES

It shall be the Awardee's responsibility to submit, at the time of, bid opening the original manufacturer's warranty of the material(s) supplied. The shelf life of all protective coatings proposed in this Bid shall not be less than one year.

The material(s) shall be guaranteed to be of correct composition and pigmentation and free of any defect. The HCSO agrees to dispute the composition or pigmentation of any container(s) within six (6) months from the date of acceptance. Any parts or portion found not in accordance with this specification will be rejected and returned to the Awardee at their expense for immediate replacement.

15. CONTRACT PERIOD

The contract shall be effective for one (1) year from the date of award. By written mutual consent between the Hillsborough County Sheriff's Office and the awardee, the contract may be extended on an annual basis for up to three (3) additional years.

16. ESCALATION/DE-ESCALATION

The Hillsborough County Sheriff's Office will allow an escalation/de-escalation provision in this bid. The escalation/de-escalation will be allowed provided the awardee(s) notify the Hillsborough County Sheriff's Purchasing Section of the pending increase/decrease a minimum of thirty (30) calendar days prior to the end of each one (1) year period for which the bid was awarded. Said notification shall consist of manufacturer's proof of increase and shall include each individual item, the amount of increase/decrease and the applicable Bid Item Number. Failure to comply with these instructions shall be grounds for disallowance of the escalation/de-escalation clause as stated herein.

17. EXCEPTIONS TO BID

All bid submittals must clearly state with specific detail all deviations to the requirements imposed upon the Bidder by the General Terms and Provisions (Part A) and Special Provisions (Part B). Such deviations should be stated upon the Bid Proposal (Part C) or appended thereto. Bidders are hereby advised that the Hillsborough County Sheriff will only consider bid proposals that meet the specifications and other requirements imposed upon them by this bid package. In instances, where an exception is stated upon the Bid Proposal (Part C), said bid proposal will be subject to rejection by the Hillsborough County Sheriff in recognition of the fact that said bid proposal does not meet the exact requirements imposed upon the Bidder by the General Terms and Provisions (Part A) and the Special Provisions (Part B).

The MPI Green Performance Standard (GPS) "requires the manufacturer shall demonstrate that the VOC concentrations of the product shall not exceed those determined by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency Reference Test Method 24", as quoted from the MPI website www.paintersinfo.com/mpi. This reference source includes acceptable VOC levels and an approved product list. This bid does not require your product be on the MPI approved product list, but will be compared to those products by the technical data requested.

Product ranking by manufacturer relates to quality. **BEST** is considered top of the line in all performance categories. **BETTER** would be considered a good performer but with a lower price. **GOOD** indicates price is top consideration for an acceptable performance.
