The purpose of this pamphlet is to educate homeless individuals on the resources available and the laws governing road side solicitation.

Violations of laws will be fairly enforced.

State Laws

Trespass - F.S. 810.09

Trespass upon state roads includes the address/location specified, and also includes, but is not limited to the entire width between the boundary lines of every street, highway or roadway, as well as any other property owned by the Florida Department of Transportation.

Pedestrian Traffic Regulation

F.S. 316.130 (5)

No person shall stand in the portion of a roadway paved for vehicular traffic for the purpose of soliciting a ride, employment or business from the occupant of any vehicle.

County Ordinances

H.C. 11-2

Roadway Solicitation

Prohibits being on the road, or within four (4) feet of the edge of the road, for the purpose of distributing materials or goods or soliciting business or charitable contributions of any kind from the occupant of any vehicle located on the state or county road. Also prohibits displaying advertising of any kind while standing upon any state or county road.

H.C. 92-7

Public Consumption of Alcohol

Prohibits the consumption of an alcoholic beverage within 500 feet of a licensed establishment or upon any street, alley, sidewalk, parking lot or right of way.
