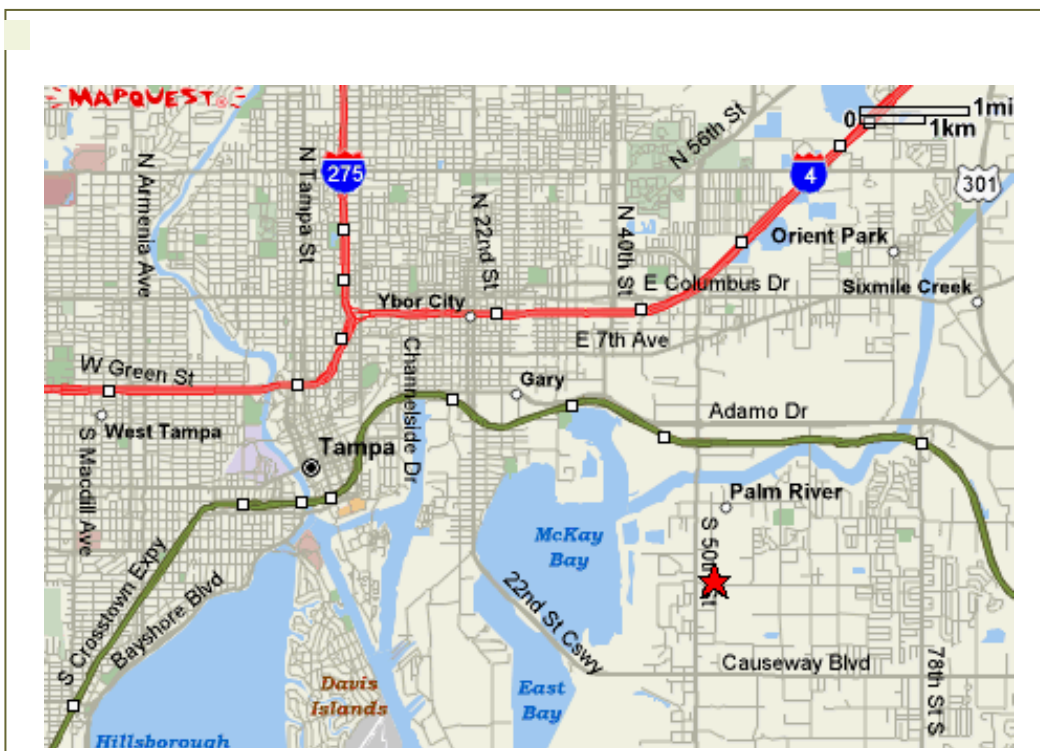
retired, and in many cases, our time is limited. I have found it very rewarding personally to have gotten involved with this worthy cause. I hope others will also.

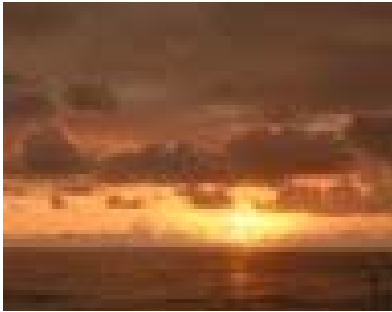
